East Hunsbury Parish Council is made up of 12 councillors who are elected or co-opted to the council, usually for a term of four years. Councillors are not volunteers but elected representatives, working together in the council to serve the community of East Hunsbury. They represent the interests of the community as a whole, bring local issues to the attention of the council, and help the council make decisions on behalf of the community.

Our councillors range from those who were elected when the council was formed in 2015, to our very newest councillors co-opted at our May meeting. All of our councillors have different backgrounds, enthusiasms and interests, but work together to make East Hunsbury a great place to live, work and play!
