CE22/015	Community Engagement update Members were provided with a report from the Community Projects Officer which gave a general update on community engagement since our last meeting, including information about the Seniors Club, the Get Active programme, parish networking, and work with constituted groups to assist with access to funding. Cllr Lewis asked whether the Seniors Club could hold a raffle/lottery. Clerk will investigate this and report back.
CE22/016	Jubilee Fete Members were provided with information about the Jubilee Fete which will be held on 3 rd June in Grangewood Park. Contractors, equipment, marquees, concessions, and bands have all been booked. Councillor attendance will be required at the event which will be family friendly, community focussed event.

CE22/018	Youth Club Cllr Roach provided members with an update on the youth club which is funded by the parish council and provided by Trilogy Leisure at Danes Camp. The feedback received has been very positive and numbers are good for both age groups. The older group is almost at capacity. Leaflets will be delivered to schools before the Easter break. It was noted that future advertising should make clear that the youth clubs are funded by the parish council.
